
This letter will set forth the proposal of Akin, Gump, Strauss, Hauer and Feld to continue representation of Frupac International in connection with any legislation pending in the United States Congress effecting the tariff on imported fresh asparagus, including, but not limited to H.R. 4255, H.R. 6064 and S. 2896.

For our performance of legal services, Frupac will continue to pay the law firm at the standard hourly billing rates of those persons working on its account and reimburse the firm for all routine out-of-pocket expenses. The total amount that shall be paid in respect of fees and other expenses shall be limited to US\$ 25,000.00 through Senate consideration of tariff legislation or October 4, 1984, whichever is sooner. Frupac thereafter may authorize additional expenditures.

Frupac shall pay the sum of US\$ 15,000.00 promptly upon acceptance. Frupac shall pay the additional sum of US\$ 10,000.00 on or before Friday, September 14, 1984. Any sums not expended shall be refunded.
