

Privacy Act Statement. This amends our responses to Questions 11, 12, 14(a) and 15(a) of this supplemental statement. First, with respect to Question 11, we did not undertake any services during this period with respect to Colombia, Saudi Arabia or Yugoslavia. We provided assistance to British Columbia on matters related to the US-British Columbia softwood lumber trade relationship. Also, with respect to Question 12, we did not provide any services to these principals during this reporting period, with the exception of British Columbia. We provided an account of our activities conducted on behalf of British Columbia in the original supplemental filing. With respect to Questions 14(a) and 15(a), we did not receive any payment from Saudi Arabia or make any related disbursements during this period for work covered under FARA.


