COST OF LIVING ENQUIRY COMMITTEE

Pursuant to discussions with the Government, Robert Nathan Associates, Inc. is prepared to supply to the Cost of Living Enquiry Committee, economic consultant services consistent with the Terms of Reference of August 31, 1960.

2. Edward D. Hollander will be assigned for three months to serve as general economic adviser to the Committee.
3. Robert R. Nathan will counsel with Mr. Hollander in preparatory work and will maintain close liaison with Mr. Holland so as to render all possible advice and aid as the work progresses and to review the final report.
4. The Government shall be charged from the date of Mr. Hollander's departure from Washington, D.C. to the date of his return to Washington, D.C., provided that compensation shall not cover more than four days of travel time at start and at end of employment.
5. First class air transportation costs for Mr. Hollander from Washington, D.C. to Accra and return shall be reimbursed to the consulting firm by the Government.
6. Housing facilities, medical care, and motor transportation in Ghana shall be furnished to Mr. Hollander by the Government. For travel in Ghana outside Accra, transportation and housing shall be furnished by the Government.
7. The Government will pay to the consulting firm \$61,050 per month during the three months of consulting services, which payment will cover all services and costs of the consulting firm except air transportation costs which are to be reimbursed to the consulting firm by the Government and except those items indicated in (6) above, which are to be supplied by the Government.
8. The consulting firm shall render an account to the Government at the close of each month and payment will be made by the Government to the consulting firm.
