THIS AMENDMENT, entered into as of the 29th day of April, 1964 between the Royal Government of Afghanistan, through its Ministry of Planning (hereinafter referred to as "Government"), and Robert R. Nathan Associates Inc., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware (hereinafter called the "Contractor") with its principal offices located at 1218 Sixteenth Street, N. W., Washington, D. C.

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, The Government and the Contractor entered into a contract on the 25th day of August 1961, as heretofore amended, providing for the Contractor to furnish certain services to the Government in connection with the development and implementation of the Government's economic and social programs; and

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WHEREAS, Contractor pursuant to criteria established by the Agency for International Development is now authorized to receive reimbursement for the cost of certain allowances paid to its employees, and

WHEREAS, the Government desires to amend the contract to provide reimbursement of such costs, and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to make other changes in the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the contract as follows:

1. Add the following two paragraphs under Article I(b), Personnel.

"4. Contractor's employees in Afghanistan shall work a minimum of forty hours per week in accordance with a schedule approved by the Ministry of Planning.

5. Contractor will maintain in Afghanistan an accurate record of days worked and leave (by type) taken by each member of its team in Afghanistan. These records shall be maintained on a current basis and made available at all reasonable times to Government, US AID Controller, and AID auditor."

2. In Section I, U. S. Dollar Costs, of Appendix A, add the following two paragraphs under Direct Costs.

"9. Education Allowances

Effective April 29, 1964, Contractor may be reimbursed for payment made to authorized employees and staff members for educational

allowances for their authorized overseas dependent children in accordance with the Standardized Regulations (Government Civilians, Foreign Areas), as from time to time amended.

10. Post Allowance

Effective April 29, 1964, Contractor will be reimbursed for payments made to authorized employees and staff members for post allowances not exceeding those paid AID employees in a Cooperating Country in accordance with the Standardized Regulations (Government Civilians Foreign Areas), as from time to time amended."

3. Wherever Article II, Method of Payment, authorizes payment of dollar costs and fee by Controller US AID, substitute "Payment by Controller, A.I.D./Washington". It is the intent of the parties that transfer of dollar payments from US AID Controller to A.I.D./W Controller shall be accomplished as expeditiously as practicable.
