PORTUGUESE/AMERICAN ADVISORY BOARD FORMED TO LAUNCH INVESTMENT INITIATIVE

WASHINGTON, DC – APRIL 25, 1995 – Former Ambassador to Portugal Frank Carlucci and former U.S. Congressman Tony Coelho will serve on the newly formed U.S.-Portugal Investment Advisory Board, Portugal's Minister of Trade and Tourism Faria de Oliveira announced today. Minister Faria de Oliveira and Ambassador Carlucci will co-chair the board, which will consist of 12 members – six from the United States and six from Portugal.

The advisory board is a part of the Portuguese government's new initiative and commitment to increasing U.S.-Portuguese trade and investment. American board members, high profile business executives with operations on Portugal, will help interest other companies in exploring the advantages Portugal offers.
