





We are pleased that the Government of Afghanistan, now duly constituted as the Interim Government pursuant to the Agreement on Provisional Arrangements in Afghanistan Pending the Reestablishment of Permanent Government Institutions, desires to retain Verner, Liipfert, Bernhard, McPherson and Hand ("Verner Liipfert") as its counsel in Washington, D.C. on legislative, trade, investment and other matters to be determined.
