

MEXICAN IMMIGRATION TASK FORCE

A task force composed of officials responsible for the formulation of Mexico's immigration policies, academics, immigration experts, and representatives of leading non-governmental organizations, agreed to work together in an effort to produce a consensus position on immigration based on agreed upon parameters.

As a result of a series of meetings designated "Perspectives and the Design of a Platform for the Development of Mexico's Immigration Policies," the Task Force developed its first white paper entitled "Mexico and the Challenges of Immigration," as a basis for the development of an agenda on this issue.

The white paper sets forth recommendations regarding the commitments that Mexico should undertake to update its immigration policies and discusses issues that should be considered in light of the immigration reform debate in the United States. In both cases, the document is grounded on the following principles:

Respect for the human rights of immigrants;
Shared responsibility;
The relationship between immigration and border security;
Regional focus.

I. Recommendations to update Mexico's immigration policies -

1. Economic and social development programs to provide people with greater incentives to stay in Mexico.

2. Taking responsibility to insure that those individuals who decide to leave Mexico do so through legal means, assuming that there are sufficient visas available for them to do so.

3. Strengthen efforts to stop those criminal entities that engage in the illegal trafficking of individuals, and the laws that are used to prosecute them.

4. Facilitate the ability of immigrants to return to Mexico and reassimilate in their communities.

5. Implement measures to strengthen security at Mexico's both the northern and southern borders and to promote regional development at the borders.

6. Modify Mexico's laws and institutions to respond to the recent developments relative to the immigration phenomenon.

II. Issues Regarding Immigration Reform in the United States -

1. Resolve the challenge facing the undocumented population in the U.S.

 - b. Establish a binational medical insurance program that will reduce the burden on U.S. taxpayers with respect to emergency medical attention for immigrants.
 - c. Streamline and update programs within the Departments of Social Development and Labor with the goal of incentivizing the return of emigrants to their places of origin.

This task force will be maintained as a permanent resource to debate and develop public policies in the immigration area.
