Dear Messrs. Chen Osorio, Vasquez Xltul and Dios Garcia:

This letter will confirm that we have agreed to represent you on in connection with the reparations project of the State of Guatemala to the communities affected by the construction of the *Hidroeléctrica Chixoy*. When we say pro bono, we mean that we will not collect from you any money for legal services we provide for you in connection with this matter.

Description of Representation

Our representation of you will involve assistance in strategy, and technical and logistical support in preparing for the reparation negotiation currently pending between the State of Guatemala and the Coordinadora (the "Negotiations"), and, if necessary, the negotiation process itself. Our representation has started on 3 June 2005.

Termination of the Rendering of Legal Services

When your case is over, we will no longer be your lawyers unless we have agreed to continue to represent you on some other case. Either of us can end the representation at any time.






