Dear Dr. Michael:

This letter will confirm that we have agreed to assist you for purposes of advocacy for Iraqi Christians by conducting an inventory of resources and support for efforts to achieve autonomy for Iraqi Christians. When we say "pro bono," we mean that we will not collect from you any money for legal services we provide for you in connection with this matter. We may, from time to time, send you invoices of our services rendered which reflect the amount of time and expenses incurred by us on your behalf but which you are not required to pay.

## Description of Representation

Our representation of you will involve conducting an audit/inventory of assets within the U.S. Government, the U.S. Congress and non-governmental entities in Washington D.C. to identify key individuals and determine the level of support and resources available to achieve autonomy for Iraqi Christians in the Republic of Iraq. We will perform an analysis of these assets and propose a plan for highlighting the plight of persecuted Iraqi Christians and the feasibility of achieving autonomy for Iraqi Christians within the Republic of Iraq. Our representation will begin on May 15, 2008.

## Fees and Costs

In the event of litigation, sometimes the courts will allow us to apply to be reimbursed for our costs (for such things as copying documents, telephone calls, overnight mail, investigators, research, etc.) and also for our attorney fees. These costs and fees will be not be paid by you, they will be paid by the other side in the case. In the event that the court issues an award of attorneys fees and costs against the other side, you agree that we will be entitled to, and will receive, the entirety of such an award (although such an award would be issued in favor of your name). A judge usually has the final say about the amount to be paid.

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
