

We will coordinate activities of a group of consultants, working in an effort to track attitudes of U.S. Government, members of the press and U.N., regarding the Cyprus conflict. We will devise a strategy towards presenting to all three areas the true positions of the Turkish Cypriot opposition to the current recognized government. The work outline herein is to last for a period of six months. Fees are \$50,000/month plus expenses incurred in conjunction with this work. The firm of Bill Hecht & Associates will receive (of the \$50,000) \$15,000/month plus expenses; the firm of Daniel J. Edelman will receive (of the \$50,000) \$10,000/month plus expenses.

- Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

We will contact and survey members of U.N. delegations, U.S. Congress and Executive branch, and the press, to determine their understanding of today's situation and their opinions regarding solutions, if any.

We will present findings to Trust and devise recommendations for strategy, based on these findings, towards proposing a lasting solution.

Most of the contacts will likely be in the form of appointments or telephone calls.
