

The Sawyer/Miller Group will assist the Government of Colombia in furthering its foreign policy objectives in the United States. This will include working with its Embassy in arranging visits to the U.S. by the President and other government officials, supervising advertising and public relations efforts in the U.S., conducting public opinion research, and providing general advice and counsel as requested by the government. It is understood that this relationship will continue for at least two years. Standard advertising commissions will be charged by SMG and expenses will be reimbursed by the Government of Colombia. The Sawyer/Miller Group will assist the Government of Colombia in designing and placing paid advertising to improve the country's image in the U.S.
