

We are a division of the British Government promoting regional, economic development in the North of England.

During the period between May 1st and October 31, 2000 both Yorkshire Forward and North of England have out-sourced various marketing firms to target and research potential new leads in addition to our own ongoing research. Both offices (Boston and Atlanta) follow up on the leads generated.

Promotional Brochures are created targeting various sectors of the economy and are distributed to generated lead potentials, multipliers and our networking contacts throughout the U.S. Listed below are the Promotional Brochures we have used this period, targeted sectors and times of their distribution. Copies of them are attached in the Supplemental Section of this report.

Included in our Supplementary Travel Statements are all conferences, seminars, multiplier and networking functions attended by our U.S. Staff.

SUPPLEMENTAL ANSWERS FOR **F.A.R.A. STATEMENT**

During this reporting period (May 1st – October 31, 2000) sixty-four individual companies were contacted.

- **Yorkshire Forward**, based in Boston, was responsible for contact with thirty-nine of the companies.
- **North of England**, based in Atlanta, was responsible for contact with twenty-five companies.

Between the two offices sixty-eight visits were made to the companies contacted. In addition to actual U.S. Staff visits to these companies **Yorkshire Forward** held, or participated in, thirty-five teleconferences with contact companies.

A combined office total of fifty-seven visits and/or teleconferences were made to our multiplier/networking contacts. For further details please see our Supplementary Travel Statements which are attached to this document.

Both offices make regular use of the e-mail system as a way to reach new companies as well as to maintain ongoing communication with the businesses we presently deal with.

During the period of May 1st through October 31, 2000 sixteen separate companies made a total of twenty-seven combined inquiries into the UK.

Atlanta

Our Atlanta office, **North of England**, has been responsible for nine of the sixteen companies visiting the Region. Each of the nine companies has visited the UK at least once. For more details on these visits please see: Inward Visits

Boston
