

Privacy Act Statement. In addition to the attached letter, Robinson, Lake, Lerer & Montgomery has a verbal agreement with Friends of Democracy in Pakistan to monitor political and policy developments in the United States that have a direct bearing on Pakistani, Pakistani-U.S. relations, and the Islami Jamhoori Ittehad ("IJI"). Robinson, Lake, Lerer & Montgomery will also provide strategic advice to the IJI for the purpose of developing an understanding of the perception in the United States of the IJI and its role in Pakistani democracy. The contract commenced in August, 1989, and is for an undetermined duration. Robinson, Lake, Lerer & Montgomery will be compensated at the rate of \$22,000 per month, plus expenses.



The IJI, also called the Islamic Democratic Alliance (IDA) in the Western media, maintains a firm commitment to democracy and to allowing the Pakistani people to shape their country's government through an open and widely accessible electoral system. To facilitate its work in the fight for democracy, however, the IJI will need not only our help, but the support of Pakistan's allies around the world.

Therefore, it is vital the party develop and maintain an open and reliable communications network in the U.S. to keep American policy-makers, the media, and the public fully aware of the IJI's goals and progress.
