

Privacy Act Statement. 

Dear Mr. Barrios:

This letter, when signed by both the Ministerio Secretaria General de Gobierno, (Ministry), and Robinson, Lake, Lerer & Montgomery/The Sawyer Miller Group, (Firm), will constitute the agreement between us with regard to our appointment by the Ministry as a consultant to the Ministry for strategic communications work.

1. Robinson, Lake, Lerer & Montgomery/The Sawyer Miller Group hereby commits itself to the provision of communications and public relations services to the Ministry "Secretaria General de Gobierno" of Chile.

2. The Firm will carry out a four-month plan of action to design, propose and implement, with the previous agreement of the Ministry, the following activities, among others:

- Strategy and relations with the media, both at the national and regional levels.
- Elaboration of material to be distributed to the press and audiences relevant to the coalition-building effort.
- Preparation of the communications strategy and material (talking-points, speeches, press briefings) for visiting senior Chileans authorities.
- Coalition-building across different relevant groups and territorial locations.
- Communications support for other Chilean initiatives.
- Compilation of relevant ordinary information (press clippings, public statements, documents).

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3. The Firm will produce a timeline of activities the week after this agreement is signed, and update it as requested by the Ministry.

4. The Firm will undertake the following reporting schedule:

- A weekly meeting with Blas Tomic
- A monthly written report on:
 - progress made on the disaggregated work program
 - general evolution and assessment of the situation

5. For our services and outlays on your behalf, you agree to pay us compensation computed as follows:

(a) The sum of \$20,000 per month for the professional consulting services of the Firm. Charges for services shall be made at our standard hourly rates listed below.

Executive Vice President	\$300/hour
Senior Vice President	\$250/hour
Vice President	\$180/hour
Senior Associate	\$120/hour
Associate	\$100/hour

(b) In addition, the Ministry shall reimburse the Firm for reasonable, actual out-of-pocket expenditures upon receipt of itemization thereof. Major expenditures -- e.g., on video projects or publications -- will be subject to prior discussion with the Ministry.

6. The term of this contract is four months beginning on March 15, 1993, and ending on July 15, 1993, unless and until terminated in writing by either party on not less than 30 days notice.

7. We agree that any and all contracts, correspondence, books, accounts and other sources of information relating to your accounts shall be available for inspection at our office by your authorized representative during ordinary business hours upon reasonable notice to us.

8. Upon termination of this agreement, if requested, we shall transfer and make available to you or your representatives

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all property and materials in our possession or control which belong to you.

9. The Firm and the Ministry agree that, in the process of providing professional services to the Ministry, the Ministry may provide sensitive confidential information, the disclosure of which would be to the detriment of the Ministry. The Firm represents that it will not use any of such information for any purpose except for the benefit of the Ministry under the professional services to be performed by the Firm under this agreement.

10. You agree to indemnify us and hold us harmless from and against any loss, damage or expense, including reasonable attorneys fees and costs, sustained by us as the result of any claim or action brought against us which is based upon information, data or the materials supplied by you to us.


11. This agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia.


