



Dear Gisela:

What follows is our proposal to produce and distribute a three-part news series. Few Americans realize how open the Federal Republic of Germany is to American products and direct American investment. Few Americans realize how many people are employed by German companies in the United States. These will be the points emphasized in our news series.

Part I will explore the day-to-day life of Paul Caligiuri. He's a twenty-two year old American who is training with Hamburger SV in West Germany's First Federal Soccer League. We'll examine his life in Hamburg emphasizing the wide variety of American products available to him.

As mentioned in Part I, Hamburg is the Gateway to West Germany. In Part II we'll explore direct American investment in Germany. 1985 was the first year West German investment in the United States exceeded US investment in the Federal Republic. Part III will examine the trend, pointing out the growing number of jobs in the US provided by West German investment.

D S Simon Productions will develop the script, arrange for spokesperson participation and shoot needed footage using a German crew for all footage shot in the Federal Republic of Germany. We'll provide you with a rough edit for your review and incorporate your suggestions into the final edited program on 1" videotape. An NBC network radio newsmen will anchor each segment which will last approximately ninety seconds to two minutes.

Once completed to your specifications, we will begin the distribution process. We will combine satellite and direct mail distribution maximizing the number of stations receiving the story and our ability to monitor usage. 600 stations will receive the satellite feed and 50 more, including the networks will receive a tape of the program. We will contact stations by phone and through the mails to determine and promote usage. We anticipate that a minimum of 50+ stations will air each segment of the news series reaching an audience in the millions. We will provide you with at least one aircheck.

Your total investment for this project is \$27,500 (American). This includes all costs of production and distribution except crew travel and related expenses. These expenses will be cleared in advance.

By having this agreement signed and returned with a check for \$13,750, you'll indicate that the terms are agreeable to you and the Government of Germany. The balance will be due upon completion of the edited master tape.
