

Dear Mr. Schochet,

This letter will confirm your representation of the Free Angola Information Service, Inc. (herein after "Free Angola") as a legal advisor, for a period of one year commencing on August 10, 1987.

1. You will be retained by Free Angola, to provide legal services and Washington representation, as that is generally understood, including public relations advice.
2. In payment for the above referenced services, Free Angola will pay a flat retainer of (\$6,500.00) per month including expenses payable quarterly and in advance. Payment shall be by wire or drawn on a local bank account.
3. Expenses which cannot be met within the said amount shall not be incurred and shall not be reimbursed without prior authorization and approval by the undersigned or a designee of Free Angola.
4. If you are in agreement with the above items and conditions, please affix your signature as designated below and on the copy attached hereto and return the original to me and maintain the copy for your records. It is also understood that you will be responsible for executing the required documents and filings regarding this agreement with the United States Department of Justice pursuant to the Foreign Agents Registration Act as it relates to your status as a legal advisor to the Free Angola Information Service, Inc.
5. This contract may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to either party hereto.
