

**INSTRUCTIONS:** A registrant must furnish as an Exhibit B copies of each written agreement and the terms and conditions of each oral agreement with his foreign principal, including all modifications of such agreements; or, where no contract exists, a full statement of all the circumstances by reason of which the registrant is acting as an agent of a foreign principal. This form shall be filed in triplicate for each foreign principal named in the registration statement and must be signed by or on behalf of the registrant.

**Privacy Act Statement.** Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, dissemination report, copy of political propaganda or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the Registration Unit in Washington, D.C. One copy is automatically provided to the Secretary of State pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act, and copies of such documents are routinely made available to other agencies, departments and Congress pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act. Finally, the Attorney General transmits an annual report to the Congress on the Administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents and the nature, sources and content of the political propaganda disseminated or distributed by them. This report is available to the public.

**Public Reporting Burden.** Public reporting burden for this collection of information is estimated to average .33 hours per response, including the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information. Dear Mr. Schochet,

This letter will confirm your representation of the Free Angola Information Service, Inc. (hereinafter "Free Angola") as a consultant for a period of one year commencing on November 1, 1989.

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REGISTRATION

- (1) You will be retained by Free Angola to provide Washington representation. As that is generally understood, includes:
  - a. Giving strategic and tactical advice and assistance in dealing with the U.S. Congress, and working in particular in the U.S. Congress, and working in particular in the U.S. Senate with Senate Democratic members and staff.
  - b. Preparation of assignments which are technical in nature and which utilize my legal background. Examples include: working on opposition activities, review of issues affecting Angola on the Export-Import Bank Act, World Bank, etc.
  - c. Creation of relations between FAIS and leading wildlife organizations as well as Jewish Community Organizations based in Washington. This includes informing and addressing the leadership of those organizations and, where appropriate, introducing them to your office.
- (2) In payment for the above referenced services, Free Angola will pay a flat

retainer of (\$5,000.00) per month including expenses payable quarterly and in advance. Payment shall be by wire or drawn on a local bank account.


- (3) Expenses which cannot be met within the said amount shall not be incurred and shall not be reimbursed without prior authorization and approval by the undersigned or a designee of Free Angola.
- (4) If you are in agreement with the above items and conditions, please affix your signature as designated below and on the copy attached hereto and return the original to me and maintain the copy for your records. It is also understood that you will be responsible for executing the required documents and filings regarding this agreement with the United States Department of Justice pursuant to the Foreign Agents Registration Act as it relates to your status as a legal advisor to the Free Angola Information Service, Inc.
- (5) This contract may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to either party hereto.
