The TPLF has information offices in several Western countries where there is a significant Ethiopian community. The decision to fund an office in the U.S. was made over the course of several years through telephone conversations, messengers arriving in the U.S., and TPLF participants returning to Ethiopia. The understanding that has developed is as follows. The registrant is obligated to follow guidelines established by the foreign principal. The registrant will inform the foreign principal of the registrant's activities and of notable events in the Ethiopian-American community. In return, the registrant will receive between \$30,000. and \$40,000. per year and will operate in perpetuity.

- Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

The registrant will distribute literature, organize meetings and conferences, and will keep the U.S. officials informed of events in Ethiopia. The registrant will communicate with the foreign principal, by phone or messenger, twice per month in order to receive information and suggestions and to inform the foreign principal of the registrant's activities.

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5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The registrant disseminates information on current events and developments in Tigray and Ethiopia to the Ethiopian-American community and to the U.S. public at-large by distributing literature, sponsoring conferences and meetings, and communicating with U.S. officials. The registrant keeps the foreign principal generally informed of the registrant's activities.
