

Privacy Act Statement. 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## AGREEMENT

This agreement is hereby made between The William Chasey Organization (TWCO) and the Church Alliance of South Africa (CASA). CASA retains the services of TWCO to provide Washington representation on behalf of CASA and help CASA organize in the United States including advisement in the development of a funding base. These activities will be carried out under the authority of Pastor M.L. Badenhorst.

This agreement will be in effect for twelve (12) months beginning February 1, 1990 and terminating January 31, 1991.

CASA agrees to pay TWCO forty-eight thousand dollars(\$48,000.00). For the convenience of CASA the payment will be payable in monthly installments of four thousand dollars(\$4,000.00). The first payment is due February 1, 1990 and will be payable in advance each month thereafter on the first day of each month with the final payment due on January 1, 1991. All payments will be made at TWCO Corporate Office, 855 La Jolla Corona Ct, La Jolla, CA 92037.
