

INSTRUCTIONS: A registrant must furnish as an Exhibit B copies of each written agreement and the terms and conditions of each oral agreement with his foreign principal, including all modifications of such agreements; or, where no contract exists, a full statement of all the circumstances by reason of which the registrant is acting as an agent of a foreign principal. This form shall be filed in triplicate for each foreign principal named in the registration statement and must be signed by or on behalf of the registrant.

Privacy Act Statement. Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, dissemination report, copy of political propaganda or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the Registration Unit in Washington, D.C. One copy is automatically provided to the Secretary of State pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act, and copies of such documents are routinely made available to other agencies, departments and Congress pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act. Finally, the Attorney General transmits an annual report to the Congress on the Administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents and the nature, sources and content of the political propaganda disseminated or distributed by them. This report is available to the public.

Public Reporting Burden. Public reporting burden for this collection of information is estimated to average .33 hours per response, including the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information. The law firm of Lepon, McCarthy, Jutkowitz & Holzworth has been retained by the Chilean Exporters' Association (CEA) for the purpose of undertaking efforts to defeat or modify pending legislation that would impose discriminatory inspection requirements on Chilean fruit exports to the United States in violation of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade to which both Chile and the United States are signatories. Those efforts will involve contacting, writing and, where appropriate, meeting with members of Congress and their staff, U.S. government officials, foreign officials, appropriate trade associations and members of the press.

In addition, the firm has been retained by CEA to undertake efforts to modify pending legislation (e.g., H.R. 4219) which would ban the sale abroad of certain pesticides;


