Present monthly report, prices, and analysis on 807 and 807A trade between CB countries and the United States. Furnish a monthly update on trade matters that are happening or developing in Washington -- both legislative and administrative issues, to encompass general trade issues, including textiles and apparel.

Work with members of Congress to obtain legislative goals and members of the Administration to achieve decisions compatible with interests of Fang Brothers Knitting Ltd. Of the two reports sent weekly, one gives textile and apparel quotas arranged by product and the second report lists textile and apparel quotas by country.

WTL will also advise and consult Fang Brothers Knitting Ltd. for bilateral textile negotiations, as called upon, for a fee of \$200 an hour.
