

Privacy Act Statement. Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, dissemination report, copy of political propaganda or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the Registration Unit in Washington, D.C. Dear Sirs,

This letter puts forth a working relationship between Kuett & Company, Inc., a company existing and doing business under the laws of the State of New York, and Curacao, Inc., a foundation formed under the laws of the Netherlands Antilles.

Curacao, Inc. hereby appoints Kuett & Company, Inc. as its communications agency with the charter of developing, planning and executing communications programs in the United States to promote Curacao as an international business, financial and commercial center in the Caribbean.

It is hereby agreed that Kuett & Company, Inc. will be compensated for its services by billing Curacao, Inc. a monthly fee of \$9,000, billable and payable on the first of each month, plus other charges hereinafter detailed.

Out-of-pocket expenses, such as postage, packing, express mail, telephone and duplicating, incurred by Kuett & Company will be billed net, as well as travel and accommodation expenses. Any outside supplier costs, such as finished art, mechanical production, display materials and photography will be billed at net cost.

This agreement will extend from May 1, 1991 until terminated by either party upon thirty days (30) written notice. During such thirty day period, Curacao, Inc. agrees to relieve Kuett & Company, Inc. of all previously authorized contractual obligations and to compensate Kuett & Company, Inc. for work performed but not otherwise compensated.
