

The African National Congress, Department of International Affairs, through its International Secretary, designated Ms. Lindiwe Mabuza to act as its Chief Representative to the United States, starting in June, 1989. Pursuant to this understanding, Ms. Mabuza is to represent the interests of the African National Congress in the United States for so long as she and the foreign principal wish and is to receive such funds as may be necessary to maintain an office and suitable accommodation.

4. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

Functioning as the African National Congress's ambassador to the United States, Ms. Mabuza is responsible for lobbying and consulting with U.S. political representatives and public officials; lecturing and giving media interviews; disseminating political information and publications produced by the African National Congress with reference to informing and persuading the government and people of the United States to continue their opposition to apartheid as practiced in South Africa and seeking their support for a non-racial democracy in which all South Africans will enjoy full human rights and fundamental freedoms.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.


