

Privacy Act Statement. 

This will summarize the basis on which the Republic of Guatemala ("Guatemala") has engaged MWW/Strategic Communications. The scope of our engagement is to provide public relations counsel and services to Guatemala in the United States as outlined in our May, 1991 proposal (Appendix A).

More particularly we will work with Guatemala to provide public relations services in connection with Guatemala's efforts (1) to promote the peace process initiated by President Serrano, and (2) help Guatemala establish the programs and ideas of President Serrano in the United States.

Services shall be provided for the period of May 21, 1991 - December 31, 1991. For our services in connection with this matter, MWWSC shall be paid a total of \$58,670.00 (U.S.\$) payable in six monthly installments of \$8,000.00 (U.S.\$) each, and one payment of \$10,670.00 (U.S.\$). The first payment is due upon signature of this Agreement. Subsequent payments are due on the 20th day of each month.

In addition to the retainer listed above, MWWSC shall be reimbursed in U.S.\$ for all expenses incurred on behalf of Guatemala. We will render statements on a monthly basis. Payment is due within 30 days of statement being rendered.
