

Privacy Act Statement. 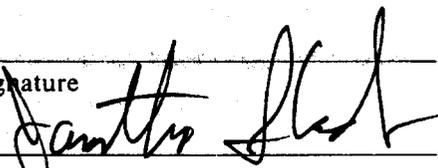

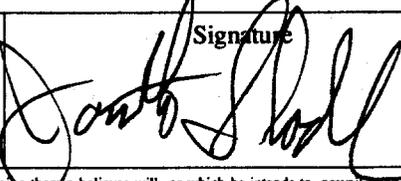

CONTRACT

This Agreement is made as of the 14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1994 by and between Interbank and MWW/Strategic Communications, Inc. (MWWSC).

I. SERVICES

Commencing upon execution of this contract, MWWSC will devote its best efforts to conduct a targeted Government Affairs program on behalf of Interbank. This campaign shall include representing Interbank before the Congress and Executive Branch.

II. FEE

MWWSC shall receive an initial retainer fee of \$50,000.00 for their services payable in one installment. This retainer is for the first five months of the Government Affairs program. The payment is due upon signature of this Agreement and will be credited towards the first five months of MWWSC's activity on behalf of Interbank. After the initial five months of this contract have expired, Interbank shall pay MWWSC an additional retainer of \$50,000 for the next five months.

III. EXPENSES

Any photocopying, postage, telephone, facsimile transmissions, article reprints, travel, meals, mileage, and other out-of-pocket expenditures will be billed separately. Reimbursements will be made within thirty (30) days of the date a statement is rendered to the client. Unpaid statements after that time will be subject to a one and one-half percent service charge. Any expenses which will exceed \$250 to any one payee within a thirty (30) day period shall not be incurred unless approved in advance by a designated representative of the client.

IV. DURATION

After 120 days, this agreement shall be subject to termination by either party upon the giving of thirty (30) days notice.

V. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS

MWWSC and all of its employees are independent contractors and not employees of the client, which agrees to hold MWWSC harmless and indemnify it for any and all claims, lawsuits, judgments, or obligations, arising as a result of work performed pursuant to this Agreement, which are not caused by nor arise from, any act of MWWSC or its employees or representatives, in whole or in part.

This paragraph does not minimize or restrict the contractual obligations of the client to reimburse MWWSC for expenses it incurs on behalf of the client in accordance with Paragraph III above.
