

Privacy Act Statement. Please accept this letter as acknowledgement of Trombone Associates, Inc. appointment as the marketing public relations agency for Plantation Bay Beach Resort & Casino, N.V. and as confirmation of the basis on which we shall operate in servicing you.

Public Relations Services

Trombone Associates, Inc. agrees to perform the following services including marketing assistance in close cooperation with Plantation Bay:

- A. Write press releases and/or special articles aimed at the trade and consumer media (newspapers, magazines, radio, television, etc.) in accordance with an action plan mutually agreed upon.
- B. Service press requests for information about Plantation Bay with the assistance and approval of the Client.
- C. Establish and maintain good relations with the press on behalf of the Client for the purpose of placing or stimulating the writing of stories favorable to the Client and supporting the Client's objectives, subject to Client's approval; escorting press visits; etc.
- D. To promote and publicize to the corporate meetings and incentive travel planners.
- E. Submit to the Client monthly reports showing media clippings and summarizing the Agency's public relations activities for the Client.

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Marketing Events & Sales Promotion

Advertising

The Agency will prepare media recommendations for Plantation Bay and when approved:

- A. Create your advertisements for appropriate media.
- B. Order the media to be used for your advertising at the most advantageous rates for Plantation Bay available.
- C. Check and verify insertions, displays or broadcasts to such degree as is usually performed by agencies.
- D. Audit and pay invoices for media bought on Plantation Bay's behalf as well as any outside preparation and services.
- E. The Agency will submit designs and concepts for various sales promotion programs as requested by Plantation Bay. Estimates for all sales promotion shall be submitted to Plantation Bay for advance approval.

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Fees and Expenses

As compensation for the marketing events and public relations services provided by the Agency, Plantation Bay, agrees to pay Trombone Associates Public Relations an annual fee of 120,000 payable in monthly installments of 10,000 beginning January 1, 1991, due as of the first day of each month.

In addition, the Client authorizes the Agency to expend during the 12 months, additional promotional and out-of-pocket expenses at a maximum of \$30,000 for such ordinary expenditures as may be necessary for the carrying out of the Client's public relations program, it being understood that these expenditures shall cover items such as the printing and distribution of press releases, postage, long-distance telephone calls, messenger services, news clipping services, the production of reports, photographs, press entertainment, necessary staff travel and such other items as may be requested by the Client.

Agency expenditures on behalf of Plantation Bay will be billed at cost when incurred and shall be supported by supplier invoices or receipts verifying the amounts involved.

A separate budget will be established for special promotions and events, to be authorized by Client prior to execution of the event.

* Printing of press kits will be an additional charge.

Agency Compensation (Advertising)

- A. All commissions paid by advertising media will be retained by us in accordance with standard agency procedures.
- B. For services rendered within the Agency, pursuant to your authorization of estimate in connection with the preparation and execution of advertising, we shall bill you at our current rates.

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- C. On any production charges such as artwork, film, velox, stats, etc., incurred by the Agency through outside sources, we shall invoice you at our costs, plus 17.65% as agency commission.
- D. If you employ the Agency to create collateral material, you agree to pay us such amounts as shall be estimated and agreed to in advance.
- E. The Agency shall be reimbursed for actual out-of-pocket expenses such as shipping charges, postage and state and local taxes.

Staff Service

The services of a management supervisor, account supervisor and assistant, as well as computer facilities, secretarial, clerical, and accounting services will be assigned to the account, all under the direction of the agency P.R. Review Board.

Trombone Associates staff members assigned to work on this account will meet as often as necessary with the representatives of Plantation Bay to discuss plans, work in progress, and results. In addition, Trombone Associates will submit written reports describing work performed and including a list of press contacts made, and press releases written.

Duration of Agreement



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


