Privacy Act Statement. 
I intend to communicate by telephone, fax, correspondence or meeting, with U.S. officials regarding whaling issues. I will provide policy and legal advice to the principal.

MEMORANDUM FOR AMBASSADOR BJARNASON

Subject: Representation

You have asked that I provide representation for the Icelandic Government with respect to whaling issues. In particular, you have requested that I provide informal assistance with communications to officials of the Clinton Administration, and perhaps, to Members of Congress. You have also asked that I keep you informed of developments in the United States Government that relate to those issues.

I am informed by the Department of Justice that, in order to comply with your request for assistance with communications to U.S. Government officials, I must file as a Registered Foreign Agent for the Government of Iceland. Accordingly, I will make the filing. With your written concurrence, this memorandum will describe my responsibilities and compensation for services.

Compensation for my services will be \$1250 per month, including fees and expenses, provided however, that any travel will be compensated separately and that, in months of increased activity on my part, your Government may choose to adjust my compensation.


