

Privacy Act Statement. 

A Letter of Agreement**For****The Retention of Barron•Birrell, Inc.**

This letter sets forth the terms and conditions for the retention of Barron•Birrell, Inc., (hereafter the "firm"), by THE REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA, (hereafter "the client"), to provide public relations, government affairs, financial relations and economic development consulting services and to provide services in connection with such other matters as shall be referred to the firm from time-to-time by the client.

In consideration of the firm's agreement to provide these services to the client, the client shall pay to the firm a professional service fee in an amount to be determined at a future date. A portion of the professional fee will be due and payable upon execution of this agreement.

Ordinary expenses incurred, such as telex, telephone, reproduction, and other out-of-pocket expenses shall be borne by the firm. Other extraordinary expenses such as foreign travel and other non-recurring expenses shall be undertaken only after consultation and with expressed approval. These expenses will be billed back. Under no circumstances will expenses be billed back with a service charge.

Invoices generated by the firm for fees and extraordinary expenses will be submitted by the firm in a timely manner and shall be due and payable upon receipt.

It is agreed that the firm is an independent contractor, without the power to bind, act for or obligate the client expressly, impliedly, or in any manner unless the client provides otherwise in writing.

This agreement shall be effective as of the date upon which it is executed and shall remain in effect for a period of one year.
