

Privacy Act Statement. PROPOSAL

Nature and Scope of Services

1. The Law Offices of Robert K. Kelley (the Law Firm) offers to provide professional counsel and representation services to Usine A. Manteque de Port-Au-Prince, S.A. In the event the Company requests travel outside the Washington, D.C. area, the Company will pay the cost of such travel (airfare to be at coach rate).
