

Privacy Act Statement. 

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**CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

The Republic of Djibouti, and the law firm Foley Hoag LLP (“the Firm”), hereby agree as follows:

**FIRST**

Professional Services provided by the Firm: The Firm shall provide advice and assistance to the Republic of Djibouti on international matters and on bilateral matters between the Republic of Djibouti and the United States of America.

**SECOND**

Payment to the Firm: For the professional services described above, the Firm shall be paid professional fees of \$25,000 per month. In addition, the Firm will be reimbursed for its expenses associated with international travel, if any, incurred at the request of the Republic of Djibouti. The Firm will absorb all ordinary costs and expenses incurred in the course of its activities on behalf of the Republic of Djibouti.

Method of Payment: The Republic of Djibouti shall pay \$25,000 to the Firm by check or wire transfer to the bank account designated by the Firm, on or before the fifteenth day of each month of this Contract, commencing in August 2004. The Republic shall reimburse the Firm for international travel expenses, if any, within 30 days of its receipt of an invoice from the Firm for such expenses.

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**THIRD**

Term: The term of this Contract is from August 1, 2004 through April 30, 2005. However, the Republic of Djibouti may terminate this Contract at any time, with or without cause, upon 15 days written notice to the Firm.
