EuroStrategy Associates, Inc, and Mr. Jean-Pierre Lemboumba, a citizen of the country of Gabon, enter this Twenty-Second day of February, 1993, into a consulting services contract whose terms and conditions are listed below.

1. EuroStrategy Associates ('The Consultant') will provide Mr. Lemboumba ('The Client') with expert advice and counsel on the communication of information to the international media and to appropriate public officials so as to promote the following objectives:
  - A. Free and fair Presidential elections in Gabon this year.
  - B. The protection and enhancement of democratic institutions and human rights in Gabon, a prerequisite for economic development and foreign investment.
  - C. Development of national political leaders most capable of ensuring the country's progress toward these objectives.
2. The Consultant's services shall include:
  - A. Analysis of national and international economic, political, and social developments related to these objectives.
  - B. Advice and counsel on communications to the media, to public officials, and to relevant national and international organizations.
  - C. Initiating contacts and organizing meetings following such advice and, in some cases, participating in such meetings.
  - D. Such other national and international advice and counsel as may be required to further progress toward the objectives stated above.


