



# Luxembourg. Your choice for Logistics In Europe

**80% of the European Union GOP can be serviced from Luxembourg in one day** - The vast majority of the European Union's Gross Domestic Product is within one day's reach of Luxembourg - 500 miles or less. Luxembourg's advanced VAT regulations have completely eliminated that process. This reduces the capital required, eliminates cost of capital and the administrative burden associated with VAT recovery. Whereas several other EU countries allow similar processes upon request and under certain conditions, Luxembourg is the only country that never requires pre-financing.

**Lowest VAT rate in the EU** - Standard Value Added Tax (VAT) rates in the European Union vary from 15% to 25%. Luxembourg has consistently had the lowest possible VAT rate across the European Union (i.e. 15%). This low rate also applies to products and services electronically delivered from Luxembourg throughout the EU. A number of large US Internet businesses (including AOL and iTunes) have taken advantage of this provision and have established subsidiaries in Luxembourg.

**Favorable tax environment and competitive labor cost** - The Luxembourg Government pursues a growth oriented and business friendly tax policy addressing the needs of the employers and employees alike. Lower indirect labor costs (health care and social security contributions) provide for a win-win situation, which leads to a lower overhead for the company and a higher net salary for the employee than in the neighboring countries.

**Easy access to government and administration** - Luxembourg's small size and the strong focus on economic diversification provides a nimble economic environment. A very close cooperation between business, government and labor has resulted in a uniquely stable business environment, where disruptive labor action is virtually unknown, and government can address business needs on an individual basis.

**Consistent EU first mover advantage** - Luxembourg has consistently been reacting very quickly to the developing EU legal and regulatory environment designed to boost the economy. For example, the quick implementation of the EU framework legislation providing for the cross-border distribution of mutual funds in Europe led to the creation in Luxembourg of the world's second largest (after the US) mutual fund industry, with total net assets under management of more than 2 trillion US dollars.

This is but a short list of the reasons that have led world-class manufacturers such as Goodyear, DuPont or Delphi Automotive and top technology companies including Skype, Apple, Microsoft, eBay, PayPal and Amazon to operate successful businesses in Luxembourg, and to capitalize - directly or via a logistics partner- on these unique circumstances and use Luxembourg as a hub to put Europe at their finger tips.
