Our office has taken part in the youth and student tourism meeting and exhibition organized by ETC (European Travel Commission) at Biltmore Hotel, New York during March 1974. In this exhibition, posters and brochures on the historical and touristic sites of Turkey have been displayed and information has been given to visitors and travel agents about Turkey. We have also participated in the ASEA (American Society of Association Execitives) travel exhibit of ETC at Hotel Americana, New York. On this occasion, we have distributed touristic brochures and supplied information to the visitors. Records of Turkish folk music have been played. Monthly dinners and meetings of ETC have been attended.

We have participated in the International Travel Fair sponsored by Matterhon Spots Club at RCA building, New York in April 1974. At this meeting touristic brochures have been distributed and information on travelling opportunities have been given.

We have attended the monthly dinners and meetings of ANTOR (Assembly of National Tourist Office Representatives), Travel Committee and SATW (Society of American Travel Writers). Here speeches have been made on subjects related to travel and tourism works. Also, information on the development of travel and tourism in the United States has been given.

We are enclosing herewith a copy of "Turkey 1974 Sales Guide" which has been prepared by our office in this six month period and which has been published in the Travel Trade, purpose of promoting travel from United States to Turkey.

No additions have been made to our list of films on travel and tourism. Our films have been sent free of charge to Clubs, Schools, TV Stations and non-political meetings.

Black and white and color photographs have been sent to travel writers and travel agencies for their programs involving Turkey. Their inquiries have been replied for prospective travellers to Turkey.

Advertisements have been run in travel magazines and travel sections of newspapers to publicize the historical and touristic importance and value of Turkey. These advertisements are completely to promote travel to Turkey. Tear sheets are enclosed. No seminars have been arranged by our office during this period.

Touristic brochures and posters which are being sent free of charge to those who request them have been published by our Ministry of Tourism and Information in Ankara.
