To this end, the Registrant released a weekly newsletter (News from Turkey), and issued booklets as listed elsewhere. The Registrant also arranged for display materials on Turkey, participated in exhibitions, gave lectures, made radio and TV appearances, etc., also as listed elsewhere. Copies of published materials were duly filed with the Department of Justice, the Attorney General, and the Librarian of Congress.
