

Agreement: Jefferson Waterman International, LLC and Gustavo Envela

Jefferson Waterman International, LLC agrees to assist Gustavo Envela enhance his standing in Washington as it relates to his political intentions in Equatorial Guinea. JWI will undertake the following in this regard:

- Make contact with various elements of the Executive Branch on behalf of Mr. Envela, sometimes with him present and sometimes separately
- Make contact with pertinent members and staff in Congress, again separately and in conjunction with Mr. Envela.
- Seek media opportunities for Mr. Envela to spread his message.
- Organize meetings with appropriate non-governmental entities in Washington, including the think tanks and democracy-fostering NGO's.
- Develop meaningful and supportive contacts with the petroleum community on behalf of Envela. The companies in which Mr. Envela is particularly interested include Marathon, Exxon Mobil, Amerada Hess—at the highest level possible.

In return, Mr. Envela agrees to pay JWI, LLC \$22,500 per month, commencing June 27, 2005 with the first payment due on that date. Additional expenses will be mutually agreed upon and paid separately. Mr. Envela intends that the contract be of long duration, although the unpredictability of events dictates that it be of a month-to-month nature.

Either party can terminate this contract with five days prior notification.
