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**PROPOSAL
FOR CONSIDERATION BY
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SENEGAL**

Jefferson Waterman International (JWI) is pleased to tender the following proposal for consideration by the Republic of Senegal in support of a visit by the Minister of Commerce to Washington DC for an event including an address and support activities to present the possibilities and advantages of investment in Senegal.

JWI shall assist the Government of the Republic of Senegal in developing the plan for a meeting with US corporations and businesses interested in expanding contact with Senegalese businesses and projects. JWI would identify a suitable location for the event, arrange support and develop an invitation list based on information supplied by the Embassy. Additionally, US media representative would be included in the event as well as relevant US government officials.

The event would consist of a "meet and greet" coffee, a luncheon program to include a formal presentation by the Minister of Commerce followed by "breakout" sessions to include brief meetings with relevant Senegalese officials for introductions useful in eventual development of projects or investments. The Washington Embassy agrees to provide written hand-out materials, arrangements for accommodations for the delegation and other support requirements.

JWI shall assist in identifying and acquiring a suitable venue, logistical arrangements for the program, the identification of potential attendees, issuing of invitational messages, confirmation of attendees, arrangements for media coverage, and a follow-up assessment of results.

The event will take place in the first or second week of February 2014. All JWI tasks will be complete by the end of that month.


Compensation:

For JWI's support of the event it will receive a one-time payment of USD \$15,000.00 in advance by 31, December 2013. All other expenses and support activity to be provided by the Embassy directly to the respective vendors.


