

Privacy Act Statement. Finally, the Attorney General transmits an annual report to the Congress on the Administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents and the nature, sources and content of the political propaganda disseminated or distributed by them. This report is available to the public.



## EXHIBIT B - Attachment 3

### Terms and Conditions of Understanding

1. JCIC understands the terms and conditions of the placing of purchase orders for TV Public Relations Programs with JCIC by the Prime Minister's Office to be as follows, as of February 20, 1995:

- (1) Fees: About Japanese yen 200,000,000.
- (2) Duration: From February 20, 1994 to March 31, 1995
- (3) Name of Programs: "Japan As It Is"
- (4) Programs to be produced and Number of Broadcastings:  
Four 27 Minute Color Programs, and One Broadcast per program.
- (5) Broadcasting Media:  
Satellite Broadcasting by KEY STONE, and 16 UHF TB broadcasting stations.
- (6) Pre-Publication of Programs:  
Through TV Guide and newspapers.

2. JCIC believes that, on or before February 28, 1995, JCIC shall have an official order sheet from the Prime Minister's Office, completed by an officer in charge of the undertaking of payment for the Government of Japan.

The Prime Minister's Office shall make its final decision whether to place a purchase order with JCIC in accordance with the terms and conditions provided for in Paragraph 1, above.

## EXHIBIT B - Attachment 4

### Method of Performance

As noted in connection with item 3 of Exhibit B, JCIC will produce four videos, each of approximately 27 minutes duration, for broadcast on U.S. television. Those videos will present aspects of Japanese culture, and will also present the position of the Government of Japan on certain issues. Such position will be presented, in part, through interviews with the Government officials and members of various ministries of the Government of Japan.
