

Privacy Act Statement. ¹Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means the dissemination of political propaganda and any other activity which the person engaging therein believes will, or which he intends to, prevail upon, indoctrinate, convert, induce, persuade, or in any other way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.

AGREEMENT

This compensation and billing procedures document is the Agreement between **THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR** and **ROXANA I. CHAHIN**, dated July 1, 1995.

THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR agrees to pay **ROXANA I. CHAHIN** a flat monthly retainer fee of \$4,000.00 for professional services to be rendered under this agreement as outlined in the attached proposal.

Invoices for the retainer fee, any U.S. Government registration fees and other reasonable expenses incurred by **ROXANA CHAHIN** on behalf of the **GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR** will be submitted monthly and shall be payable upon receipt by **THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR**.

ROXANA I. CHAHIN acknowledges responsibility, both during and after the term of its Agreement, to use all reasonable efforts to preserve the confidentiality of any proprietary information or data developed by **ROXANA I. CHAHIN** on behalf of **THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR** or disclosed by **THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR** to **ROXANA I. CHAHIN**.

It is understood that **ROXANA I. CHAHIN** is not responsible for the acts of **THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR** or representations made by **THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR** upon which **ROXANA I. CHAHIN** acts in providing services under this Agreement.

This Agreement is effective immediately upon signing based on a flat monthly retainer fee basis for a period of 6 months. An agreement for continued representation beyond the aforementioned period will be renegotiated by **ROXANA I. CHAHIN** and **THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR**.

This agreement represents the entire Agreement of the parties and may be amended only by a writing signed by both parties. It shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Arlington, Virginia.

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
