

Privacy Act Statement. 

Dear President Rene:

Per our earlier discussions, this letter is to memorialize our agreement regarding my representation of the Seychelles before the United States Congress and the Administration.

I propose the following terms for your approval:

1. I will undertake as an independent contractor to represent the interests of the Seychelles before the United States Congress and the Administration for an initial period of twenty-four (24) months. At the conclusion of that time, the engagement can be terminated by either party with thirty (30) days notice.
2. My representation will focus on the promotion and strengthening of ties between the United States and the Seychelles to ensure a long-lasting relationship between the two nations, with specific regard to U.S. diplomatic and military activities in the Seychelles and in the Indian Ocean.
3. In exchange for services rendered, the Government of the Seychelles will deposit \$10,000 (U.S.), divided equally into two accounts, on the first day of each month of the engagement. Specifically, a deposit of \$5,000 will be made via wire transfer to an account in a United States financial institution of my designation. The second \$5,000 (U.S.) will be converted into Seychelles Rupees based on the exchange rate published in the *Wall Street Journal* on the last business day of the preceding month, and deposited into a designated bank in the Seychelles.
4. Funds deposited in the United States may be withdrawn at any time. Funds deposited in a designated bank in the Seychelles may be withdrawn during the course of the engagement only to purchase real and/or personal property physically located in the Seychelles. Upon termination of this agreement or successor agreements, however, funds deposited in the Seychelles may be withdrawn from the bank in the Seychelles without restriction.
5. Interest on late payments shall accrue at the rate of nine percent (9%) simple interest.

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
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6. The Government of the Seychelles will submit to U.S. jurisdiction in the event of any disputes arising from this agreement. This agreement shall be governed and interpreted pursuant to the laws of the District of Columbia, United States of America.
7. Any controversy or claim arising out of this agreement that is not satisfactorily settled between the parties shall be settled by arbitration, in accordance with the International Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association. The number of arbitrators shall be one. Arbitration shall take place in the District of Columbia, United States of America. Language of the arbitration shall be English.
8. This agreement may be amended only by the execution of a written instrument to that effect, signed by both parties.
9. This agreement constitutes the full and complete agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter contained therein.
10. In the event that any part of this agreement is found to be void, the remaining provisions of this agreement shall nevertheless be binding with the same effect as though the void parts were deleted.
11. The waiver of any provisions of this agreement shall not be valid unless in writing and signed by the party to whom is charged.

If you are agreeable to my undertaking the representation on the basis outlined in this letter, please signify this by signing both copies and returning one to me. If you would like to discuss these matters further, please feel free to give me a call.

Again, I appreciate your confidence and look forward to working with you and the Government in this endeavor.


