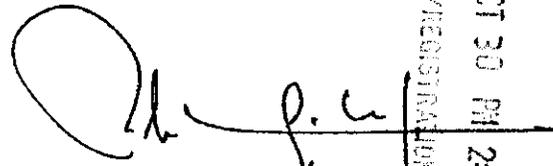

Dear Mr. McEntee:

I am pleased to address you in reference to the Letter Agreement dated March 13th, 2002, where it was agreed that your firm would provide advisory services to this **MINISTRY OF ECONOMY** to prepare and implement a strategy to represent the Government of Argentina in matters related to the package of international financial assistance required by the Republic, including the development of relationships with the international financial community, and also to advocate the National Government's position before international financial institutions, and various U.S. Government agencies. It is noted that such engagement was approved under the **NATIONAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH** Decree N° 533, dated March 20th, 2002.

In this connection, we wish to advise you that the grave economic crisis prevailing in our country has caused serious budgetary restrictions that prevent us from continuing to retain your services. Therefore, you are hereby notified that we are exercising our right to early termination of the above mentioned agreement effective September 13th, 2002, in accordance with clause 10 of the Terms of Reference attached to the Engagement Letter. We are ask you to send a report to this Ministry detailing the tasks carried out by your firm since the engagement date.
