Re: Professional Services Agreement

Dear Ambassador Maguy Maccario Doyle:

Greetings. The purpose of this retainer letter is to describe the terms of our legal representation.

1. Description of Services. We will advise you and your Embassy on behalf of Département des Relations Extérieures et de la Coopération, an official branch of the Monaco Government, in connection with the proposed District of Columbia tax haven law. At your request we will advise you on any related matters.

Under the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA), we are required to register with the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) and pay an initial registration fee. FARA requires us to label any communications we prepare and send on behalf of your government. FARA also requires us to file every six months a report, setting forth our activities and pay an additional fee. The information filed with the DOJ is available to the public.

2. Professional Fees. Our fees for these professional services will be charged as follows: Fees of \$500.00 on an hourly basis for all professional services rendered by the undersigned, who is the partner supervising the matter, and normal hourly rates for other members of the firm in the event any of my colleagues have to become involved. We periodically review and adjust our billing rates, normally at the end of the year.

3. Reimbursable Expenses. Reimbursement will be required for our out-of-pocket expenses incurred in connection with our services, including the expense of any long distance telephone calls, filing fees, fees for certificates and apostilles, special postage, photocopies, computer research, transportation, transcripts or other expenses incurred on your behalf, and the sending and receiving of facsimiles.

4. Initial Retainer. The firm normally requires an advance of the initial estimated fees. For the initial work, we request an initial advance of \$3,000.00.

In the event you want to pay future fees and/or costs by wire transfer, our account is with Bank of America, Washington, D.C., [REDACTED] Routing [REDACTED] For international wire transfers, the SWIFT code [REDACTED].

We will bill both time and expenses against the retainer, and when it is fully used we will bill and expect payment in accordance with the terms stated in the preceding paragraph. We will deposit the retainer in our operating account and will not hold it in a separate account. If, at the conclusion of our representation, there are funds remaining in the retainer, we will refund that balance along with a bill reflecting the final services rendered and disbursements posted and charged.

Once the initial advance is exhausted, we may require an additional advance as a condition of continuing our representation. If we have to represent you in court in a civil or criminal case, we will need an additional substantial advance.

5. Monthly Statements. All fees for professional services and reimbursable expenses will be billed monthly and are payable upon receipt of the statement.

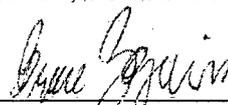
6. Managing Attorney. The undersigned attorney shall be the managing attorney responsible for supervising the professional services to be rendered.

7. Document Handling. You authorize us to retain your documents and correspondence related to this engagement, and to destroy them at our discretion after three years from the date we last provide material services for this assignment.
