

QUESTION 4:

ONLF-USA shall engage in advocacy, public relations, research, educational, and other tasks as requested by ONLF including but not limited to:

1. representing ONLF before the United States Department of State, United States Congress, the President of the United States, and any other United States federal government agencies and institutions;
2. representing ONLF before other institutions located in the United States including but not limited to: foreign diplomatic offices, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), multilateral institutions, the media and educational Institutions.
3. representing ONLF before state and local governments in the United States.
4. as the representative of the ONLF, ONLF-USA is also authorized to engage in negotiations on behalf of the ONLF.
5. ONLF-USA shall not engage in any acts that violate the laws of the United States and of the states.

FEEES AND EXPENSES:


1. ONLF-USA shall engage in the above acts without compensation. ONLF-USA shall provide the above services on a volunteer basis.

DURATION:

The duration of this oral agreement or understanding is 6 months from the filing of the FARA registration statement to the Department of Justice.

QUESTION 7:

1. ONLF-USA shall maintain facilities and personnel that are reasonably adequate to perform its obligations under the terms of this Agreement. ONLF-USA shall have the duty to perform all



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
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activities in compliance with the laws of Washington D.C. and the United States. ONLF-USA shall inform ONLF of any tasks ONLF-USA cannot perform for any of the above reasons.

2. ONLF-USA through Mohamed W. Abas, Hanad Mohamud, Mohamed I. Sagal, will engage in activities described above under the Section: Terms and Conditions section.
3. ONLF-USA shall cover all of its expenses without compensation or reimbursement by ONLF, except as otherwise provided in this Agreement.
4. ONLF-USA may represent other political parties only with prior consent of ONLF.

QUESTION 8:

1. ONLF-USA will contact U.S. government officials in the U.S. State Department, U.S. Congress, White House, and other governmental departments and institutions.
2. ONLF-USA will contact various state government officials to advocate that United States extend political, economic, and business support for ONLF in the Ogaden.
3. The purpose of the above contacts are
 - (a) to coordinate meetings between ONLF officials and U.S. and state government officials;
 - (b) to educate above government officials about the Ogaden region and the plight of the Ogaden people, and the political, economic, and social conditions of the Ogaden people;
 - (c) to advocate for establishment of independent sovereign state of Ogaden;
 - (d) to advocate for establishment of democratic institutions, free and fair elections, legal systems in the Ogaden;
 - (e) to advocate for lifting of trade restrictions and for free trade;
 - (f) to advocate for political actions and decision by the United States to support ONLF.
4. ONLF-USA intends to disseminate information in support of the above activities. ONLF-USA intends to contact the publish flyers, reports, brochures, and other written material. ONLF-USA also intends to contact popular media such as television, radio, newspaper, internet, and other media to disseminate information. The above list is not exhaustive. Should other forum become available ONLF-USA will use such forum as well.
5. ONLF-USA also intends to conduct fund raising in the United States including donations, events, and other related fund-raising activities.
