

Privacy Act Statement. AGREEMENT

Hannaford Enterprises, Inc. (hereinafter "HEI") wishes to engage the public affairs services of BKSH & Associates (hereinafter "BKSH"), commencing June 16, 2003 on behalf of HEI's client the Russian Information Agency (hereinafter "RIA").

SCOPE OF WORK

BKSH will provide HEI with counsel regarding RIA's communications strategy relating to the United States Congress, the Executive branch of the U.S. Government and U.S. political entities. Its activities on behalf of RIA will include, but not be limited to, arranging meetings between visiting Russian dignitaries and members of the U.S. groups named above; and promoting and helping arrange for Congressional delegations (CODELS) and Congressional staff delegations (STAFFDELS) to visit Russia.

TERMS and CONDITIONS

This agreement is to be for the balance of the calendar year 2003, the same as HEI's with RIA. It is subject to cancellation on thirty (30) days written notice by either party (a provision that also exists in HEI's contract with RIA).

For its services, BKSH will receive from HEI a fee of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per month, except for June 2003, in which the fee will be Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the half month. Payments will be due BKSH within seventy-two (72) hours of HEI's receipt of funds from RIA. In addition, BKSH will be reimbursed by HEI for normal out-of-pocket expenses in connection with its work on behalf of RIA. Any travel, other than local, must be approved in advance by HEI.


GOVERNANCE
