



Dear Ambassador Lee:

This letter sets forth the terms and conditions of the engagement of McGuireWoods Consulting LLC ("McGuireWoods") by the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office ("TECRO") for services provided by McGuireWoods.

Pursuant to the services provided by this agreement, McGuireWoods shall render government relations and related public communications services to assist and work with the TECRO in Washington, D. C., in promoting and strengthening the Republic of China on Taiwan's relations with the United States and, in general, providing such other appropriate advice and assistance as will serve to achieve these purposes.

In consideration of the services provided by McGuireWoods under this agreement, TECRO shall pay McGuireWoods a retainer fee of \$25,000.00 dollars per month, payable in advance, without deduction or withholding.

The agreement shall be effective as of May 15, 2006, through May 15, 2007. The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the term of this engagement. Request for contract renewal should be made two (2) months prior to contract expiration date.

Ordinary expenses (i.e., copying, faxing, long distance telephone, local travel and meals, etc.) incurred by McGuireWoods on TECRO's behalf shall be borne by TECRO, and are capped at \$1,000.00 per month. Other expenses, such as domestic and international air travel and other non-recurring expenses, shall be undertaken only after consultation with and approval by TECRO, and shall be billed to TECRO separately.
