

Privacy Act Statement. Our services will include enhancement of the GOB's relationship with the U.S. Congress and the Executive Branch including but not limited to U.S./GOB bilateral trade, Trade Promotion Authority, Andean Regional Aid, Andean Trade Preference Act and International Narcotics Legislation.
2. In consideration for consulting services described above, GOB agrees to pay Griffin Johnson \$25,000 per month, ~~plus reasonable business expenses~~. Fees and expenses will be billed monthly in advance with invoices due upon receipt. *PTM MF*
3. This agreement is effective during the period April 16, 2001 through April 15, 2002.

In the event that Griffin, Johnson believes that there may be a conflict of interest, Griffin Johnson will advise GOB immediately.
5. Griffin, Johnson strictly adheres to all U.S. laws governing the representation of a foreign government before the Congress and the Executive Branch.

Con el fin de que se haga el traspaso correspondiente, me permito transcribir a continuación el texto de la Nota EMBO/RREE/144/01, de fecha 26 de abril de 2001, dirigida a este Despacho por la Embajadora de Bolivia en Washington D.C., Dña. Marlene Fernández del Granado.

"Excmo. señor Ministro:-----  
De acuerdo con la decisión de contratar un bufete de abogados que asista a la Embajada de Bolivia en Washington en temas que respondan a los intereses del Estado, solicito a usted, muy respetuosamente, el envío de la autorización pertinente para que mi persona, en representación del Gobierno de Bolivia, firme un contrato de un año, por el valor de \$300,000,00 (trescientos mil 00/00 dólares americanos), con el señor Peter Madigan, en representación de la firma Griffin, Johnson, Dover & Stewart. Los términos específicos de la relación con la mencionada firma están contenidos en el borrador de contrato enviado previamente a su Despacho.
