

- Participated in the 2015 in the FIME Medical Devices Annual Exhibition on the 5-7 August 2015, in Miami Florida to showcase Malaysia rubber products particularly medical gloves and condoms.
- Attended the TC 157 meeting organized by the International Standards Organization (ISO) on the 14-16 September 2015 in Washington DC, for an update of the development of standards by ISO on condoms and female contraceptives.
- Participated in a Specialized Mission on Medical Gloves in Johannesburg, South Africa on September 29 - October 2, 2015 to update healthcare professionals on the latest development of medical gloves by Malaysia, and meeting South African companies to explore and assess their demand and supply capabilities, as well as seeking opportunities to promote the Malaysian rubber medical products .
- Working visit to was conducted to promote Malaysian rubber automotive components in Detroit, Michigan on October 28-30, 2015. Together with some Malaysian companies, a number of American automotive rubber parts companies were visited with a view to have better understanding of the U.S. automotive parts industry.
- Exhibited at the 2015 Automotive Aftermarket Products EXPO (AAPEX) on 3-5 November 2015 in Las Vegas, NV to promote Malaysian rubber automotive products.
