

Privacy Act Statement. Re: Letter of Agreement

Dear Mr. Ambassador:

Pursuant to our discussions, this will serve as a binding Letter of Agreement between the Embassy of Greece and Clark & Weinstock (C&W).

C&W will serve as public policy analysts and strategic advisors to the Embassy of Greece on issues of importance to the Government of Greece in its relations with the Government of the United States.

I will personally lead the C&W Washington team and will be assisted by other C&W consultants, including my partner Vic Fazio, as well as Sandi Stuart, Dave Gribbin, Brian Bieron and Jim Mathews. In addition, in a case by case basis, consultants in our New York office, Fred Garcia and Daniel Cruise, will participate as part of the team.

C&W consulting fees will be \$35,000/mo. for 6 months, commencing September 1, 2001 through March 1, 2002, unless modified by mutual agreement or canceled on 30 days written notice by either party. Business class travel and all other reasonable out-of-pocket costs incurred related to this engagement will be billed, at cost without mark-up, on a monthly basis.

C&W hereby agrees to keep confidential any and all information it receives concerning the Embassy of Greece, the Government of Greece, and its interests. Our obligation to keep information confidential will survive the termination of this agreement. The Embassy of Greece and the Government of Greece hereby agree to indemnify and hold C&W and its officers, employees and other agents harmless from any and all claims, liabilities, costs and expenses, including reasonable counsel fees and expenses, arising out of, or in connection with its services provided under this agreement and the use by the Embassy of Greece of the media and any print material prepared hereunder for the Embassy of Greece, its licensees or assignees. Please note that C&W may have to make filings disclosing its relationship with the Government of Greece under applicable law.

The foregoing indemnity will not apply to the extent that any such claim, liability, cost or expense results from negligence, willful violations of law or bad faith on the part of C&W, its officers, employees or other agents in connection with, or arising out of, the services which are the subject of this letter.

Mr. Ambassador, I hope this fully reflects the sum and substance of our discussions. Please feel free to call if you have any questions or wish clarification on an issue raised herein.

If this agreement comports with your understanding and expectations, please sign and return one of the two originals to me.
