Video Distribution Agreement

November 8, 2001

In connection with our arranging for the placement of Embassy of Cyprus video program "BEYOND DIVISION Re-unifying the Republic of Cyprus" with junior and senior high school teachers, school library services, colleges and universities as well as other interested educational audiences throughout the United States, Video Placement Worldwide (VPW), a division of JD Kommunikaters, Inc., proposes the following terms for our agreement:

VPW will duplicate each Embassy of Cyprus video on separate high quality video tapes directly from your duplication master. The Embassy of Cyprus video will be placed with educators who have specifically requested the Embassy of Cyprus video subject categories or title.

If available Embassy of Cyprus literature will be sent with the videos at no additional charge, unless it increases the postage. VPW will invoice the Embassy of Cyprus as the group placements are completed.

VPW will provide Embassy of Cyprus with an advance audience report based on the information given to VPW by the group leaders actually receiving the videos.

A user survey will be conducted and the results of that survey will be provided to the Embassy of Cyprus upon survey completion.

Actual video users will remain on file and available to Embassy of Cyprus at any time after the initial placement.

The initial budget will be \$24,675.00 to cover approximately 2,500 placements of the Embassy of Cyprus educational video. The first 1,000 placements will be billed at a rate of \$10.00 per placement plus postage. Each placement beyond the first 1,000 will be billed at a rate of \$8.00 per placement plus postage, which is currently \$1.07 per placement. VPW will not exceed the above specified budget without express written permission from the Embassy of Cyprus.

Further, the Embassy of Cyprus will provide VPW with a broadcast quality video duplication master of your program for tape duplication purposes. VPW will duplicate the Embassy of Cyprus program on high quality video tapes in the tape format most preferred by the using station from the master provided by Embassy of Cyprus.

Programs will be permanently placed with selected cable and broadcast television stations in the largest US markets, in an effort to reach the largest number of viewers. Station usage will be tracked for a period of at least at least three months after each program placement.

VPW guarantees at least one telecast at each station where the Embassy of Cyprus program is placed or we will make a new station placement at no additional charge. Extra telecasts during the three month placement tracking period will be reported at no additional charge.

The budget, for cable television placements on the Embassy of Cyprus program, will not exceed a total of \$8,500.00 for all station contact, tape duplication, shipping, handling, postage, and reporting services for program placement to stations. Television charges are invoiced upon tape placement at a station at a rate of \$85.00 per station placement, which includes postage.

The Embassy of Cyprus will pay all invoices within 30 days of receipt. A late charge of 1.5% per month will be added to all past-due balances.

The Embassy of Cyprus shall, at its own cost, indemnify, defend, and hold VPW harmless from any claim or demand which may be made or asserted by reason of a claim of violation or infringement of trademark, trade name, copyright, literary, artistic, dramatic, personal, private, civic, or property right, or the right of privacy of any individual, firm, corporation, or association, arising from material provided by the Embassy of Cyprus to VPW. VPW shall have the right to participate in the defense of any action or actions brought in connection therewith.

VPW will create a custom video jacket cover for insertion into a plastic windowed vinyl cassette jacket. The jacket cover will wrap around the video jacket covering the back, front and spine of the cassette jacket. The jacket cover will be three color and original in design. The cost for producing such a jacket cover for the BEYOND DIVISION video program will be \$360.00 for creative and design and \$820.00 to print 2,500 jacket covers for a total cost of \$1,180.00 to produce 2,500 jacket covers for school and group distribution.

In summary, the total program budget will be as follows:




