

Privacy Act Statement. 

DCI Associates, LLC, a Washington, DC-based government relations company (henceforth called "DCI"), forwards the attached invoice in the amount of 100,000 USD to our Client, the Government of Myanmar (henceforth called "Myanmar"), as advance deposit for consulting services to be performed by DCI upon completion of a Retainer Agreement therein describing services to be performed. Acceptance of the aforementioned amount does not imply that DCI and Myanmar have yet completed the Agreement for the performance of specific services. We agree that should the two parties be unable to come to an agreement, all monies received will be refunded to Myanmar.



Terms of Agreement


1. The Agreement is between the State Peace and Development Council – Union of Myanmar (“Myanmar”) and DCI Associates, L.L.C. (“Associates”) and is for the period of May 3, 2002 – May 15, 2003. The parties acknowledge and agree that it was on May 3 that DCI Associates, L.L.C. accepted Myanmar as a client and agreed to undertake the work on behalf of Myanmar. Either party may terminate this contract for any reason by providing 30-days written notice to the other party.
2. Associates acknowledges that \$100,000 USD was received on April 4, 2002 as a deposit made before Associates accepted the project and prior to any work being undertaken. The parties now acknowledge that the \$100,000 is intended to cover Associates’ management fee for the period of May 3 – July 15, 2002. Beginning on July 16, 2002 and continuing through May 15, 2003, a monthly management fee of \$35,000 shall be paid (via wire transfer), with payment due by the 15th of each month, beginning with the July 15, 2002 payment, and continuing through the payment on the 15th of April 2003. The parties acknowledge that the initial payment of \$100,000 and the \$35,000 monthly management fee is intended to cover work and activities to be performed by Associates, including Washington, D.C. representation, strategy, research, writing, third party outreach, media relations and basic government relations services.
3. The management fee referred to in paragraph #2 above does NOT include ordinary and necessary out-of-pocket expenses. Those out-of-pocket expenses will be invoiced separately, and in addition to, the management fee referred to in paragraph #2 above.
4. Additionally, the fee referred to in paragraph #2 above does NOT include any special project-type fees and expenses. Those expenses would be approved in advance by the client, and would be invoiced separately, and in addition to, the management fee referred to in paragraph #2 above.
