An individual registrant at Alston & Bird LLP submitted informational material to the editor of a newspaper. The individual registrant notified the editor of the requirement to post a conspicuous statement at the beginning of the article that discloses that the article was prepared by an agent on behalf of a foreign principal, and that additional information is on file with the Department of Justice, Washington, District of Columbia, but this disclosure was not included in the informational material as published by the editor (a copy of which has been filed with the Registration Unit). The article itself does disclose that the registrant is helping to advance the foreign principal's agenda in Washington.

We answered "No" to Line 23 and provided the above explanation pursuant to previous advice from Heather Hunt, Bureau Chief, and Jeff Gilday, Intelligence Research Specialist, as referenced in the Supplemental Statement covering the six month period ending on October 31, 2009.
